**Our full scale art center includes:** painting and drawing classrooms, a metal design facility, a photography classroom complete with darkroom, a complete pottery facility featuring a classroom with handbuilding space as well as 13 potter's wheels and a satellite pottery room with 3 potter's wheels and a firing facility with 3 kilns.



**Painted Pottery! – Art Doing Good**  
-Our painted pottery facility features handmade items by local artists. Come in and paint your own pottery anytime we are open. **There is never any sitting fee! Just pay for what you paint!** Proceeds from the studio support the art council's scholarship and outreach programs for youth in our community!



**On our walls!** – The Pitt County Arts Council at Emerge features five gallery spaces within our facility. The Edwards Gallery and the Wooten Gallery are our two main exhibition spaces hosting a new show every 6 weeks! Satellite galleries including the Evans St. Gallery, the 4<sup>th</sup> St. Gallery, and 5<sup>th</sup> St. Gallery feature smaller shows on a rotating basis as well!

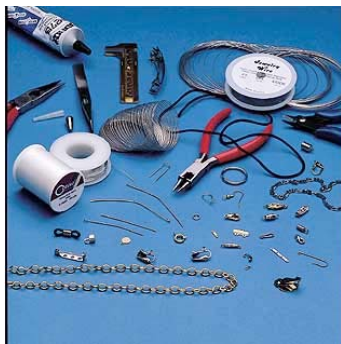

# PCAC -Adult Art Clubs

### METALSMITH – Metal & Jewelry Club

Membership to Metalsmith is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our metals program. This membership will run six months. Membership entitles you to use our facilities any time during scheduled open hours whether you are currently enrolled in a class or not, the ability to purchase metal at class rates, plus free use of studio materials during open sessions. Currently open studio is scheduled for Wednesday evenings from 6pm until 8:30pm and Saturdays 10am until 3:30pm - but depending upon interest more may be added. A trained metals instructor is always present.

Eligibility: You must have taken at least 2 metal design classes at the Pitt County Arts Council at Emerge. ### THE FIRING CIRCLE - Pottery Club

Membership to THE FIRING CIRCLE is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. If you have not taken a pottery class through Emerge you must first enroll in the Clay Studio Orientation Class prior to joining THE FIRING CIRCLE.

Members of the Firing Circle are paying only for use of the kiln facilities. They are not eligible for use of the pottery facility including wheels, tables, equipments, etc. This is simply a club for those individuals who wish to create and work on their artwork off site but need kiln usage.

(Those wishing to use the Emerge Facility should enroll in Mudhole). Clay and glazes are not included. Clay may be purchased at class rates. Clay not purchased at Emerge is not permitted. Dues run on a 6-month basis. Members pay for firing by drying room shelf load.(REG CODE – FIRC-01)Membership Rates: \$25 for members, \$65 for non-members  
Firing Rates: \$10 per drying room shelf

### MUDHOLE – Pottery Club

Membership to MUDHOLE is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. Dues run on a 6-month basis. Membership entitles you to use our facilities any time during our open hours whether you are currently enrolled in a class or not, the ability to purchase clay at class rates, use of glazes, and your work will be fired through our facility. Members are issued a membership card allowing use of the facility, but must also sign in during each use.

### Eligibility:

You must have taken at least 2 pottery classes at the Pitt County Arts Council at Emerge. Your instructor must sign off on our Mudhole Waiver stating that you can wedge, center, trim, and glaze successfully without supervision. If you are unable to do so, we will recommend you take another class prior to working alone and enrolling in Mudhole.

\* If you have pottery experience, but have not taken a class through our facility you must first enroll in the Clay Orientation Class prior to enrolling. Membership Rates:
