SCHWA 2010

Introduction

A national juried competition recognizing excellence in craft and fine art.

Eligibility

This exhibition is open to any artist in any media and subject matter. All work must have been completed in the past 3 years and not previously exhibited at PCAC. All pieces must fit through a standard size door. Work must be available for the entire exhibit. Video entries are accepted but special equipment must be provided. Work must be "ready to hang" or will not be eligible even if accepted. All work must be framed and wired. No sawtooth or hook style hangers.

Entries & Fees

Each artist may submit up to 5 entries. The entry fee is \$15 for 3 entries and \$5 for each additional entry with a limit of 5. Check should be made payable to PCAC at Emerge. All work must be labeled with title and artist at time of delivery. All work must have a sales price or insurance value.

Deadlines

Digital Entries: Entries will be received in digital, JPEG format and labeled with "lastname_firstname_title.jpeg." Entries must be postmarked by Wednesday, July 21st, 2010. Accepted work must be delivered to Emerge by 4 pm, August 22nd, 2010.

Walk-in Entries: Entries will be dropped off on Friday, August 27th from 11 am – 8 pm and on Saturday, August 28th from 10 am – 3 pm. Works being shipped must also arrive by this time. Work not accepted must be picked up on Sunday, August 29th from 1 pm – 4 pm or Tuesday, August 31st from 10 am – 9 pm.

Pick Up

Work must be picked up by Saturday, September 25th from 2:30 pm – 4 pm or Sunday, September 26th from 1 pm – 4 pm. Work left after September 26th will become property of Pitt County Arts Council at Emerge. Work shipped will only be returned if accompanied by a shipping label.

Awards

There will be 3 cash awards:

- 1st place – \$500
- 2nd place – \$250
- 3rd place – \$100

Juror

Rachel Berry graduated from Davidson College in 2008 with a B.A. in art history. She is currently Director of Programs and Exhibitions at Visual Art Exchange (VAE) in Raleigh, where she has coordinated over 60 exhibits. She has curated numerous shows including Window-Down: Beyond Street Art and eNTER aCTION, which featured the work of five new media artists. Most recently she co-curated dual/FOCUS, an exhibition of printmakers and photographers at the Block Gallery in Raleigh.

Commission

It is assumed that all work is for sale unless noted with an insurance value. Emerge will retain a 40% commission (30% for ECU students). If work is not for sale, an insurance value must be given and NFS stated or work will not be insured. Payment will be mailed within 45 days of the end of the exhibition.

Insurance & Liability

The Pitt County Arts Council at Emerge will provide insurance for accepted work during the exhibition dates only. Work will not be insured after September 25th, 2010. Work will be insured only for the portion of the sales price. Consent to reproduce for publicity, catalogue or educational purposes is assumed, unless specifically reserved in writing. Submission of entry constitutes agreement to all conditions. Insurance value must be a realistic value, and may be questioned and proof of similar sales asked for.
