Our full scale art center includes: painting and drawing classrooms, a metal design facility, a photography classroom complete with darkroom, a complete pottery facility featuring a classroom with handbuilding space as well as 13 potter's wheels and a satellite pottery room with 3 potter's wheels and a firing facility with 3 kilns.

The Edwards Gallery and the Wooten Gallery are our two main exhibition spaces hosting a new show every 6 weeks! Satellite galleries including the Evans St. Gallery, the 4th St. Gallery, and 5th St. Gallery feature smaller shows on a rotating basis as well!

Advanced Metal Design & Enameling

Join us for this hands-on, two-part workshop, taught by Gail Ritzer, a local handbuilder and ceramic sculptor who excels in the surface treatment of clay works. This workshop is designed for intermediate and advanced ceramicists who wish to explore various surface treatment techniques.

Workshop I: Wet Clay Surface Design

In this hands-on workshop, participants will experiment several methods to create interesting surfaces on wet clay. This workshop will cover incising/drawing on underglazes and creating texture using small molds, unlikely objects such as shells, stamps, and more! THE FIRING CIRCLE - Pottery Club

Membership to THE FIRING CIRCLE is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. If you have not taken a pottery class through Emerge you must first enroll in the Clay Studio Orientation Class prior to joining THE FIRING CIRCLE.

Members of the Firing Circle are paying only for use of the kiln facilities. They are not eligible for use of the pottery facility including wheels, tables, equipments, etc. This is simply a club for those individuals who wish to create and work on their artwork off site but need kiln usage. (Those wishing to use the Emerge Facility should enroll in Mudhole). Clay and glazes are not included. Clay may be purchased at class rates. Clay not purchased at Emerge is not permitted. Dues run on a 6-month basis. Members pay for firing by drying room shelf load. (REG CODE – FIRC-01) Membership Rates: \$25 for members, \$65 for non-members Firing Rates: \$10 per drying room shelf

MUDHOLE – Pottery Club

Membership to MUDHOLE is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. Dues run on a 6-month basis. Membership entitles you to use our facilities any time during our open hours whether you are currently enrolled in a class or not, the ability to purchase clay at class rates, use of glazes, and your work will be fired through our facility. Members are issued a membership card allowing use of the facility, but must also sign in during each use.

Eligibility:

You must have taken at least 2 pottery classes at the Pitt County Arts Council at Emerge. Your instructor must sign off on our Mudhole Waiver stating that you can wedge, center, trim, and glaze successfully without supervision. If you are unable to do so, we will recommend you take another class prior to working alone and enrolling in Mudhole.

* If you have pottery experience, but have not taken a class through our facility you must first enroll in the Clay Orientation Class prior to enrolling. Membership Rates:
