Part of the Emerge's mission is to make the arts accessible to the entire community. For every five paid programs, one is completely free and targeted towards at-risk or disadvantaged youth. We do this through art programs geared towards those affected by cancer in the hospital, artist in residency programs, and our Youth Arts Initiative program, which includes scholarships and our Youth Public Arts Project.

Youth Public Arts Project is our longest running outreach program. Started in 2005, this is a bi-monthly program, where at-risk youth come to the arts council to work with professional artists and musicians to create various public art projects and learn about the rich heritage of African American music. The public art is then displayed throughout the community.

Art is Good Medicine is an arts in healthcare program in partnership with local healthcare providers Vidant Health. Professional visual artists and dancers work with adult and pediatric cancer patients and survivors. In addition, we facilitate weekly art experiences at Hope Lodge and offer free workshops to cancer patients, survivors, family members, and caregivers.

Scholarships are offered to disadvantaged children in our community to attend classes and workshops free of charge.

- Payment may be made by check, cash, or credit card.



Payments & Refunds:

- Payments must be made in full. Deposits are not accepted!
- There will be NO refunds (full or partial) five days prior to a class.
- Full refunds are available up to two weeks in advance, minus the processing fee of \$20.
- Full refunds must be requested in writing via mail, in person, or via email to paula@emergegallery.com

• Partial Refunds are available after two weeks on a sliding scale up to five days prior to class and include the deduction of the processing fee of \$20.

The scale of what Emerge will retain if a cancellation occurs:

- 12 13 days prior 10% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 10 11 days prior 20% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 8 9 days prior 30% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 7 days prior 40% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 6 days prior 50% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 5 days prior 60% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- After 5 days prior no refund is given

• In the case of Emergency, sickness, or similar events, please contact Paula Rountree at Emerge Gallery & Art Center concerning your situation and need of a refund. Each situation is examined on an individual basis. Decisions are made by the Education Committee.

• In the event of any refund, the Emerge Gallery & Art Center will retain a \$20 processing fee.

• Emerge does not offer makeup classes in any form for classes missed due to no fault of our organization.

This includes switching classes or sessions.



THE FIRING CIRCLE

Membership to The Firing Circle is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. If you have not taken a pottery class through Emerge, you must first enroll in the Clay Studio Orientation Class prior to joining The Firing Circle. Members of the Firing Circle are paying only for the use of the kiln facilities. They are not eligible for use of the pottery facility including wheels, tables, equipment, etc. This is simply a club for those individuals who wish to create and work on their artwork off site, but need kiln usage. (Those wishing to use the Emerge Facility and supplies should enroll in Mudhole.) Clay and glazes are not included. Clay may be purchased at class rates. Clay not purchased at Emerge is not permitted. Dues run on a 6-month basis. Members pay for firing by drying room shelf load.

Cost: \$25 for members, \$65 for non-members **Firing Rates:** \$10 per drying room shelf

MUDHOLE

Membership to Mudhole is open to all current and previously enrolled students taking classes through our pottery program. Dues run on a 3-month or a 6-month basis. Membership entitles you to use our facilities any time during our open hours, whether you are currently enrolled in a class or not, the ability to purchase clay at class rates, use of glazes, and your work will be fired though our facility.

3 Month Membership: \$95 for members of Emerge, \$135 for non-members **6 Month Membership:** \$145 for members of Emerge, \$185 for non-members

Eligibility: You must have taken at least 2 pottery classes at Emerge Gallery & Art Center. Our Pottery Coordinator and your instructor must sign off on our Mudhole Waiver stating that you can wedge, center, trim and glaze successfully without supervision.

If you are unable to do so, we will recommend you take another class prior to working alone and enrolling in Mudhole.

*If you have pottery experience, but have not taken a class through our facility you must first enroll in the Clay Orientation Class prior to enrolling in Mudhole.





As a benefit of enrollment in our ceramics program, current students are able to come in and work during our open hours. If the main studio is in use, there is a satellite studio that is always open.



HANDBUILDING: A STILL LIFE

Do you enjoy working with your hands? Anything is possible with clay. In this class, you can create your own personal 3D Still Life. You choose the objects you want to make! You can design your own still life or replication objects from your life. This class will focus on form, light and shadow, and the process of traditional techniques in ceramics: coil, pinch, and slab building. We will learn how to utilizes form to bring your drawing skills into sculpting skills.

[Min. 4, Max. 6]

Ages 16 and up or by special permission for senior project.

Supply fee for all ceramics classes are \$20 per bag of clay. This also covers all glazes and firing as well.

HANDBUILDING: A FUNCTIONAL LIFE

Design your own kitchen wares and bring them home. In this hand building class, we will create utilitarian objects that you will design for your common everyday use. Ever wished you could have a mug with a handle to fit your thumb just right, or a plate that had a perfect ledge for scooping up that last yummy bite? We can make it! Everything from mugs, butter dishes, sugar bowls, plates, fruit bowls, and more! Designed by you for you!

[Min. 6, Max. 8] Ages 16 and up or by special permission for senior project.

Supply Fee for all ceramics classes are \$20 per bag of clay. This also covers all glazes and firing as well.

INTRODUCTION TO WHEEL THROWING

If you've never tried the potter's wheel but have always wanted to, then this class is for you. If you've thrown on the wheel before but need a refresher or are new to Emerge, then this class is for you too! During this introductory class, you will learn the fundamentals necessary for throwing cylinders and bowls. The session will focus on techniques for centering, opening, pulling, trimming, and glazing. By the end of the session, students will have several finished pots to take home. Class size is restricted so students can get the technical instruction required to establish a good foundation for continued learning. This class is a prerequisite for continuing pottery classes.

[Min. 4, Max. 6] Ages 16 and up or by special permission for senior project.

Supply fee for all ceramics classes are \$20 per bag of clay. This also covers all glazes and firing as well.

CONTINUING POTTER: BEYOND THE BASICS

Continuing students will hone their skills at centering, opening, and pulling during this 6 week class. Projects are designed to help improve the fundamentals necessary for crafting well made cylinders and bowls. Advanced skills such as increasing scale, pulling spouts, and attaching handles will be addressed to challenge potters who have more wheel experience. Each project will include glazing and surface decoration discussions. This class is project driven and will allow students to take home several functional pieces! Introduction to Wheel Throwing is a prerequisite to this class.

[Min. 6, Max. 8] Ages 16 and up or by special permission for senior project.

Supply Fee for all ceramics classes are \$20 per bag of clay. This also covers all glazes and firing as well.

METALSMITHING: MOLD MAKING

In this class, you will learn how to create one part and two part molds. You may select natural or found objects and create a mold that will be used in the casting process. You will learn how to make your own mold, pull a wax form and then create any type of jewelry or object with it. Your wax will then be mailed off to a casting company and returned to you. You will also learn how to finish your cast object, or even use your cast creation in a larger format.

[Min. 4, Max 6]

All materials included plus cost of casting 2-3 molds in bronze.

METALSMITHING: ENAMEL

For thousands of years, craftsman have employed the art of enameling to put color and imagery on metal, which often meant dangerous chemicals or painstaking labor. But with the development of new techniques like roller printing, galvanic etching, and custom toner decals, creating detailed and interesting enamel jewelry has never been this easy or safe! Over the course of the class, students will have the chance to learn a variety of enameling techniques, including stencils, basse taille, champlevé, and cloisonné, as well as how to etch copper to produce unique pieces. [Min. 4, Max 7]

INTRODUCTION TO METALSMITHING: "I MADE IT MYSELF"

That's what you'll tell friends when they ask about the unique piece of jewelry you're wearing. Learn metalsmithing techniques such as sawing, filing, soldering, and riveting to make a variety of projects. First-time participants will make a bracelet that involves all of these basic methods. Returning participants will work with the instructor to problem solve, refine their basic skills, and explore more advanced techniques such as enameling, etching, alternative materials, and stone setting. [Min. 6, Max 7]

Supplies are included with the exception of fine metals, such as silver, that students may wish to use in class.
